

Junior Road Safety Officer (JRSO)

The Junior Road Safety Officer Scheme is open to Primary and Junior schools across South Yorkshire and encourages children to take responsibility for their fellow pupils by addressing road safety issues on a regular basis.

How does JRSO work?

Each school is asked to nominate two enthusiastic year six pupils* to act as JRSOs or the role could be advertised within school and the children apply for the job.

Each school is supplied with an information pack containing:

- JRSO Handbook
- Stickers
- Posters
- ID Cards
- Pencils
- Lanyard
- Document Wallet

With the help of the Road Safety Team and in-school support the JRSOs task is to promote road safety initiatives enabling them to get road safety messages across in a fun and dynamic way by:

- Maintaining a notice board
- Running Competitions
- Presenting in assemblies
- Producing posters and leaflets

At the end of the year the JRSOs are asked to submit a folder of their work along with their completed handbook. The best JRSOs will be awarded prizes for their hard work. Every JRSO receives a certificate.

Joining the scheme

The JRSO scheme is open to any Primary or Junior School in South Yorkshire. To participate please contact your local authurity Road Safety Team who will be happy to meet with you to discuss the scheme further.

When you have picked your JRSOs complete the 'Information Sheet' and return it. Once we have received your information we will be in touch to arrange an informal meeting with the school representative and the JRSOs



Recruiting to the scheme

There are many ways you could recruit your JRSOs these include:

- Pupils apply for the job and are interviewed for the post
- Pupils nominate themselves/others and are voted for by their peers. They
 could run a campaign explaining why they would be good at being the
 school's JRSO.
- The class teacher could nominate suitable candidates.
