



# Benny's "Lockdown Lookout"

Hi, I'm back with some more things for you to lookout for.....

First - the answers to last week's questions



This is a **TOUCAN CROSSING**. Both pedestrians and cyclists riding their bikes can cross the road here, so a way of remembering it's name is that 2 can cross here.....get it.....Toucan 😊  
If the green part is lit, then you are allowed to cross - but just check first that the traffic has stopped.



Underneath the box, on all the new pedestrian crossings is a cone that turns.....did you know?  
This cone spins when the green man is lit, so it tells blind or partially sighted users when it is safe to cross.



Here we have 2 signs - a round sign gives us an order - so this round sign tells drivers they must only drive up to 10mph.  
This is because there could be children about - which is what the triangle sign tells us. Triangle signs are a warning.  
This sign is on the way to our local park.



So - do you know what this sign means? How many have you seen?  
This sign will be used by Fire Fighters!! It is a **Fire Hydrant** sign = H for Hydrant, The top number tells us the size of the water pipe in millimetres (100mm) and the bottom number tells us how many metres (2m) away the pipe is from the sign  
This is where the pipe can be found.



Look out for the signs and then look for the pipe/hydrant cover.



The traffic light sequence = Red, Red/Amber, Green, Amber, Red



No footway for 400 yds

This sign doesn't mean that there are giant people! 😊  
It means there is no pavement so pedestrians may be walking in the road. It's a triangle sign -it is a warning to drivers.



This is a **speed camera**.  
It makes sure drivers are on their best behaviour and keeping to the speed limits and therefore making roads safer



I like to have a ride out on the bike, do you?

But have you noticed how many different cycle signs there are?

So this week we are concentrating on cycling and what we need to look out for.....

And remember, to keep yourself safe on your bike or scooter, wear your cycle helmet
